


How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?


### NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




### **AVG & MEDIAN POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS**














# **DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (YORK REGION)**














## **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
