







JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR YORK REGION

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?













DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (YORK REGION)

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?













DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (YORK REGION)












JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
